

STATEMENT OF RISK BASE CAMP ADVENTURE LODGE LLC (STUFF HAPPENS WAIVER)

Base Camp LLC, hereinafter referred to as BC, is located in a harsh environment. Because of the potential for extreme elements, varying landscapes and temperatures, you've got to help us do everything you can to increase your odds of having a safe and enjoyable experience.

The activities you may be involved in while here and in the surrounding area have risks. While we have experience in the area, we'll never know everything and as a result, injury and or death may occur. While we don't feel it's likely, after all we live here, it's possible, and reading the Grand County Search and Rescue logs online, it happens more than every now and then.

Extreme weather conditions are possible to include, heat, cold, water, lightning, wood, stone, insects, bees, snakes, and critters of various shapes and sizes too numerous to mention. You may slip, fall, trip, and nature has worked long and hard in this environment to provide numerous options for accidental injury or on occasion death. You may obtain vehicles of various sorts from us to include truck, jeep, ATV, trials bike, canoe, kayak, side by side, or stuff we bought after doing this waiver. BC personnel do reasonable maintenance on all BC vehicles and we wouldn't let you ride anything we wouldn't ride. Still, during an outing the condition of the vehicle may change due to normal wear and tear, extreme heat or cold, and or damage by you, to the vehicle. If you feel uncomfortable at any point in your abilities or the safety of the vehicle, return to Base Camp in the safest way possible. Take no chances. Assume danger lurks around every corner.

Because of the possibility of potential peril in every day conditions, do not jeopardize yourself and or others. BC is relying on your representation you do not have any medical condition, physical or mental, which would limit your ability to care for yourself or others or react in emergency situations. Rescue or emergency medical response may not be available for an extended period of time due to remote location or lack of communications ability to contact emergency personnel.

As it is likely BC personnel have more experience in the area of Base Camp than you do. It's absolutely vital you follow our direction or instruction. If children or pets accompany you in any activities, BC is placing it's trust in you that they do not have any emotional, mental, or physical disabilities that would decrease all our odds of having a safe and pleasant experience.

There is a snake under every rock, a scorpion everywhere you sit. Because someone else walks around a two foot wide, 1,000 foot drop off Chicken Corner trail, you don't have to. There are drownings in the river every year. There are injuries and occasional death on Hurrah Pass and various other hiking and riding trails. I'll show you pictures of BC ATV #3 at the bottom of a 180 foot ravine and our Ford 350 at the bottom of another ravine. Don't take chances. If at any point you feel uncomfortable call it a day and return to Base Camp to fight another day.

RELEASE OF LIABILITY: BC has been as clear as it can be about the 24 hour a day risk of injury or death. I agree to follow all BC procedures and direction. On behalf of myself, my heirs or personal representatives, I hereby waive, release, and forever discharge BC, it's owners, officers, agents, managers, employees, insurers or representatives from any and all claims for damages for death, personal injury, or property damage which I may have or which hereafter accrue to me or to my survivors, heirs or representatives as a result of my existence at Base Camp and or the surrounding area. This release is intended to discharge, in advance, BC, from any liability arising out of or connected in any way with my existence at Base Camp. I understand that nobody is perfect and people make mistakes and it's possible for BC owners, officers, agents, managers, employees, insurers, or representatives to make such a mistake that results in injury or death to myself. I further agree to indemnify, defend and hold BC harmless from any damages or injury I may suffer which damage or injury arises from my actions or omissions or the actions or omissions of third parties.

STATEMENT REGARDING PHYSICAL CONDITION/MEDICAL AUTHORIZATION: I do not have a physical or medical condition, which would in any way limit me from acting in an emergency situation to protect myself and assist other participants and company personnel. In the event I am injured during my time with BC I hereby authorize BC to administer first aid or emergency medical care and/or to arrange for my rescue, medical evacuation and care, I agree to indemnify, defend and hold BC harmless for any damages or injuries I may suffer or any costs that may be incurred by reason of such first aid, emergency medical care, medical evacuation or rescue. In the event that my condition prevents me from furnishing instructions to medical personnel regarding my care and treatment, or prevents BC personnel from contacting my family or other persons who could give directions regarding my care and treatment, I hereby authorize BC personnel to furnish such instructions to medical personnel furnishing me care and hereby release, discharge and forever waive any claim I may have against BC by reason of such medical care instructions given by BC to medical care providers.

HELP US, HELP YOURSELF: Do not go anywhere without letting someone know and taking a walkie talkie with you. It's more than difficult to find somebody here and particularly when we don't know which direction you've gone. While we've learned to track fairly well, a dusting of wind can eliminate any clues we may be searching for to find you, or what's left of you.

AGREEMENT TO COMPLY WITH RULES AND FOLLOW DIRECTIONS: At all times during my stay at Base Camp and surrounding area, I agree to conduct myself in such a manner as not to subject myself or those around me, BC personnel, or their property to risk of injury or loss. I specifically agree at all times to follow the directions and instructions given me by company personnel and I understand that if I don't, they'll boot me.
